A famous director once told me that 95% of trouble and difficulty comes from the same 5% of actors over and over again. Don't be part of that 5%. As a casting director I cannot in good conscience bring in an actor who I know has a history of causing problems on the set. Producers talk and word gets around. This is really a small town and you can quickly gain a reputation that you don't want. There are people who Production Companies have told me that they never want to see again. There are Production Companies who have told me not to bring in anyone that is represented by a specific manager.

Every production is like an emergency where timetables are tight and every problem is a big one. If you want to work regularly you want to be known as a reliable and versatile part of the solution.
